PARENT NOTICE FOR RIGHT TO REQUEST TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

The Keystone Central School District receives federal funds for a program that is part of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA)*. Based on current law you have the right to request information about the professional qualifications of your child's teacher(s) and paraprofessional(s). A paraprofessional provides academic or other support for students under the direct supervision of a teacher. If you request this information the School District or your child's school will provide you with the following in a timely manner:

- a) Whether the teacher has met State certification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- b) Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived (is not being required at this time).
- c) Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline for which they are certified or licensed;
- d) Whether the teacher has met State-approved or State-recognized certification, licensing, registration, or other comparable requirements.

These requirements apply to the professional discipline in which the teacher is working and may include providing English language instruction to English learners, and/or special education or related services to students with disabilities.

e) Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
