NOTE: Any person who knowingly enrolls or attempts to enroll in the schools of a school district on a tuitionfree basis a student known by that person to be a non-resident of the district or any person who knowingly or willfully presents to any school district any false information regarding the residency of a student for the purpose of enabling that student to attend any school in that district without the payment of a tuition charge shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor. Anyone who knowingly or willfully provides false information on this form can be referred for criminal prosecution.
