

## **Student Contract**

Clayton Valley Charter High School has a policy that all students must abide by the code of conduct that includes good behavior, positive attendance and compliance with the rules of the school. Students who violate this policy will receive disciplinary consequences that include detention, Saturday School, In-School Suspension, Suspension from school and expulsion. Students in violation of the student contract are subject to expulsion.

Students who are habitual truants (three days of unexcused absence) will be assigned Saturday Schools for all three days of truancy and all future days of truancy and placed on an attendance contract. Saturday School days may be carried over to subsequent school years. Students who continue to accumulate truancies will be in breach of the student contract and will be subject to the expulsion policy of CVCHS. This violation will be enforced by the Governing Board of CVCHS.

Seniors who violate the code of conduct policy may be subject to the loss of senior activities, including Senior Brunch, Senior Ball and Graduation.
